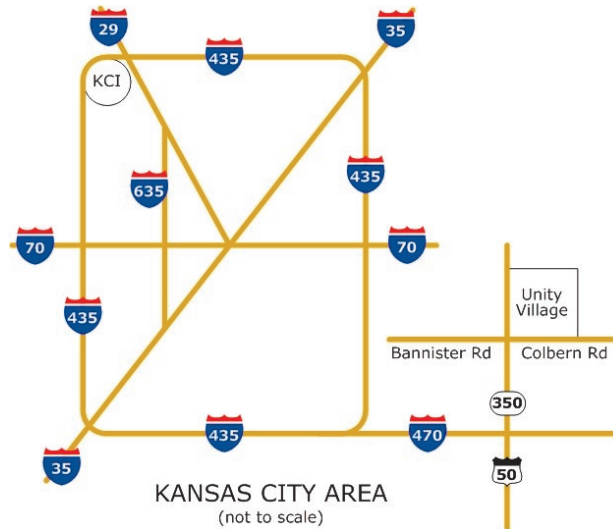

Life on the ground includes ideas, emotions, beliefs, and sensations. It is filled with beauty, laughter, and accomplishment. It is challenged by attachments, desires, and preferences.

Heaven is the ultimate truth of non-dual reality — a realm that cannot be perceived by the five senses. It informs our actions and allows for the peaceful appreciation of the relative world. When my heart is in heaven, I am the center of a universe that has no center. When my feet are planted firmly on the ground, I celebrate the richness and texture of the relative world.

This retreat will provide experiential learning in awareness, stillness, aliveness, and presence — the threads that weave two worlds into one. Instruction in mindfulness will illustrate the texture of the relative. Guided meditations will facilitate glimpses into the non-dual. Drumming circle and group discussions will provide opportunities to collaborate.

Breakfast and lunch on Saturday will be taken in silence.

- Participants will come away with the ability to create deeper relationships with other men. They will understand how those friendships are an integral component of spiritual practice — that they facilitate a deeper connection with one's self, which ultimately leads to a deeper connection with God.

- Discover the value of transcending the limitations of male conditioning, while at the same time honoring the traditions of good conversation and fellowship. Relationships among men are frequently characterized by joking or teasing, and many of us are trained that anger equals strength, but our strength lies in the ability to express a full range of emotions without being controlled by them.
